## <u>A brief guide to available models (Baroque design F/C) of Recorder (Mar 2017)</u> (This document will no longer be updated)

**Prices:** the prices stated are the lowest retail prices stated by the websites of the small number of retailers selling a range of Recorders in the UK ('£?' indicates price unknown; 'sole' indicates sole known manufacturer of particular Recorder type). Each manufacturing company produces many more models than are listed below but usually only the 'entry level' models in each particular category of Recorder are listed (EL? indicates the entry level model is seemingly unavailable; where the 'entry level' model is uncertain then an identifiable model in the category is substituted) . Prices are not listed for independent makers (e.g. Blezinger, Cook, Cranmore, Diesen, Lockwood, Sorel, Takeyama, Von Huene, Wenner).

Categories of instrument: Prices stated are for Baroque Recorder Design at modern pitch (A=440/442hz) although prices for modern designs of Bass and larger instruments are included (note: plastic instruments are effectively modern designs with Baroque styling). Each size of instrument (e.g. Descant) has been sub-divided into 4 bands according to material density (which has some bearing on the sound and cost of the instrument)

- Plastic (or plastic and wood combination) for beginner
- Wood soft woods (lower density) usually a variety of Maple or European Sycamore (Genus Acer), or variety of Pear (Genus Pyrus) for students
- Boxwoods or wood with a similar tone often a type of Boxwood including European Boxwood (Buxus sempervirens) and Castelo Boxwood (Calycophyllum multiflorum); or variety of Olive (Genus Olea); or variety of Plum (Genus Prunus). These are denser woods are warm sounding for graduate/professional ensemble and solo work (bracketed letters indicate woods: Plx=Plum wood (unspecified), Olx=Olive wood (unspecified), Ca = Castelo Boxwood; EB = European Box wood; Bx=Boxwood (unspecified); Bu=Bubinga; Ha=Haldina
- Rosewoods (aka Palisanders) and Ebonies these are very hard tropical woods of the Genus Dalbergia (Rosewoods) and Genus Disopyros (Ebonies) that are brilliant sounding for graduate/professional solo work. Bracketed letters indicate woods: Rx=Rosewood (unspecified), RC=Cocobola, RG=Grenadilla, RT=Tulip wood; Pax=Palisander (unspecified); Ex=Ebony (unspecified).
